


VALIDATE LOG ENTRY AGAINST A PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCE

Validation means that the log entry can be used to satisfy WPBA evidential requirements. Supervisors should ensure that they have objective, corroborative evidence before validating entries. This can also be used for adding additional curriculum statement headings. Follow the steps outlined below to validate an entry.

1. Click on 'Shared Log' on the left menu.
2. When you have found the entry you wish to validate, click the  icon next to the entry.
3. This will open up the entry.
4. Click on 'Validate Against Competence'.
