This gentleman's health belief system with regards to his perception of the origin of his back pain was explored. The chronological sequence of events was ascertained.

My initial thoughts centred on excluding the groin pain being secondary to a hernia.

Examination : no hernia, no focal neurological signs, no hernia. He reported no red flag symptoms. This thorough examination was fed back to the patient who subsequently felt reassured.

The advice given regarding the TENS machine this man had recently bought was purely based on simple rationale.

Towards the end of the consultation, a summary of the findings and management plan was

The consultation was drawn to a close with an open appointment should further problems reoccur. This was made on the basis of the Croft et al Studies (BMJ 1998) which stated that acute back pain often persists after many months....it is just that patients do not like to bother the Doctor again.

Simple back advice augmented by a leaflet was given in order to promote self help behaviour.
